ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning, [child's name]! I'm so glad you were born. And I'm so glad Jesus was born, too!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, this time of year can get so busy. Help us slow down and remember the good news that You gave us Your Son, Jesus, and that is what Christmas is all about."



Drive Time

While on the go, tell your child the story of when they were born. Then, tell them the story of when Jesus was born. Mary and Joseph went to Bethlehem. There were no guest rooms so baby Jesus was born in a stable. Mary laid Jesus in a manger, and the shepherds came to see Him.



Bath Time

Add toy farm animals to bath time. As your child plays, ask them what sound each animal makes. Then, ask your child what sound a baby makes. Talk about how baby Jesus was born in a place where animals live because there were no guest rooms for Joseph and Mary.
