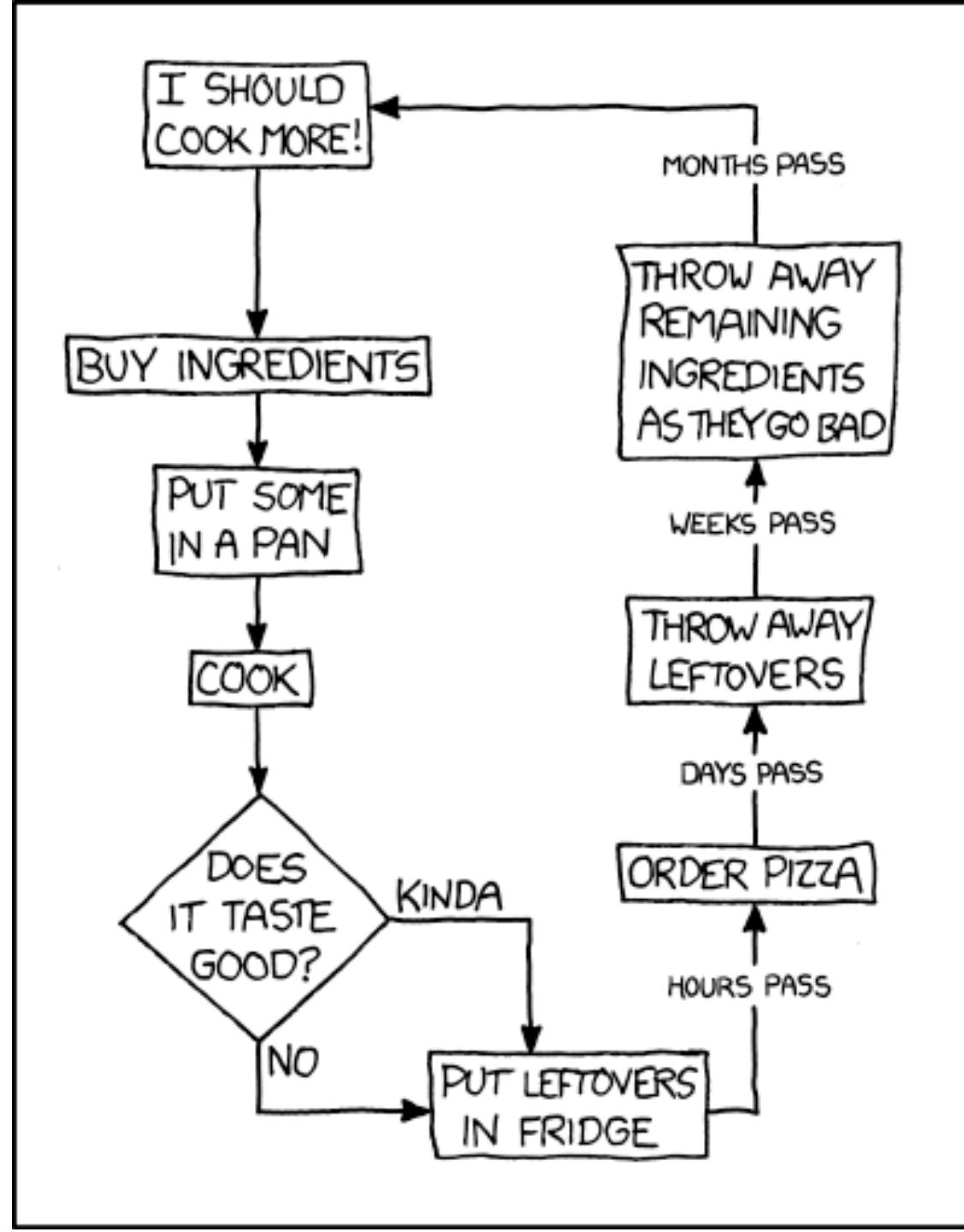
A Brief Lesson in Flow Charts



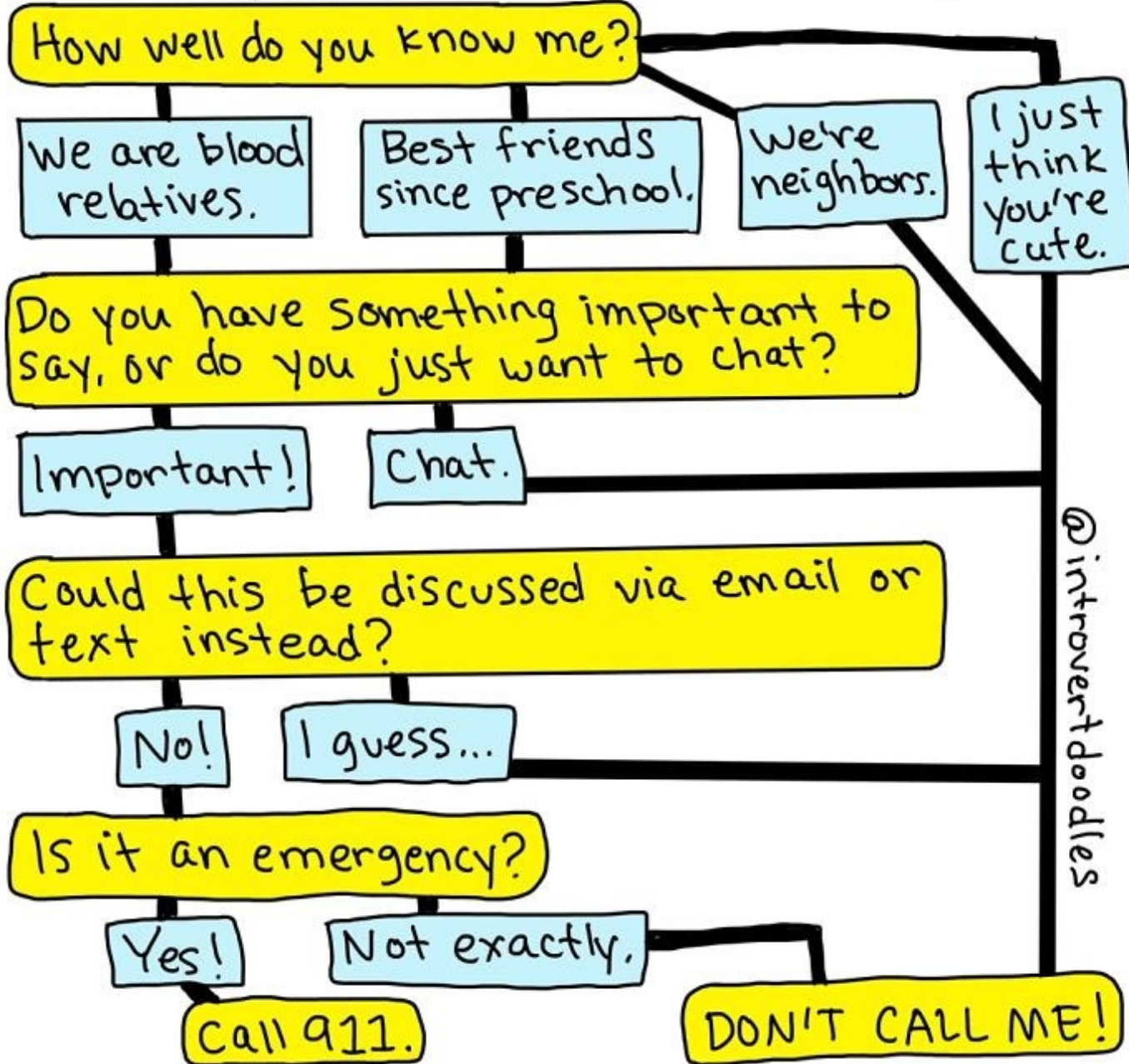


Laboratory Troubleshooting Flowchart



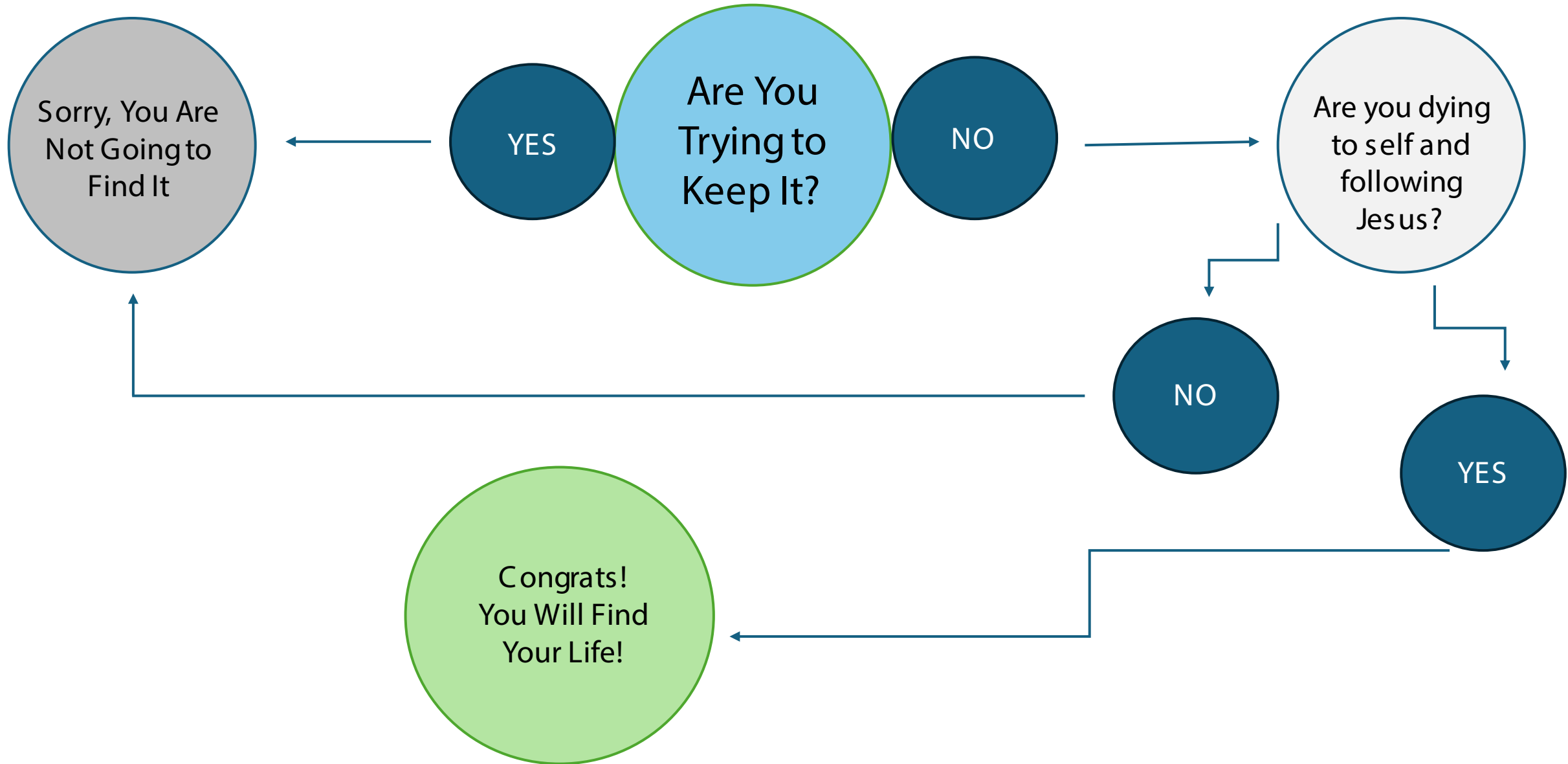




ROMANS 12:1-2
